Dear all,

On behalf of the colleagues, many thanks for the constructive first round of technical meetings during the last few weeks. As indicated earlier, we are very much looking forward to discuss a second set of newly identified measures the coming weeks so that we can receive further clarity on the eligibility of the identified measures and to hear which information would be further needed for your assessment. We also welcome any comments and questions in writing prior to the next meetings so that we can prepare accordingly.

Please find attached the new set of fiches on various policy areas that we would like to discussing during the next meetings:

- Wednesday 7 April, 14h-17h: Component 3 (investment) and Component 5 (digital)
- Monday 12 April, 10h30-12h: Component 6 (housing)
- Tuesday 13 April, 11h-12h30: Component 4 (green)
- Wednesday 14 April, 13h30-15h: Component 1 (health) & Component 2 (labour and education).

We note the fact that the amount of our proposals is quite high and that the fiches are not evenly distributed per component. If needed from your side, please feel free to make any suggestions on the number of fiches you would like to discuss exact session. This would also help us to ensure to invite the required colleagues each session accordingly.

Please note that we have positively assessed these proposals, but that these are still subject to discussion on Wednesday the 31st of March between different directors from the relevant ministries. After the discussion on the 31st we may send additional fiches or changes to the fiches that we are sharing with you now. However, we wanted to share these fiches with you already now to give you sufficient time to study the documents to facilitate our discussions starting on the 7th of April. Also I would like to add the disclaimer that these proposals are not yet decided upon by our government. They will be part of a package for the new government to take into account when deciding which measures fall under a Dutch RRP.
