Realising that the meat industry was the subject of important societal debates, Vion has been engaged in corporate social responsibility (CSR) since quite a few years.

Last year in April 2017, we published our first CSR report. It was the tangible proof of our comprehensive reflection on the major themes in the European meat industry.
