RE: ms WESTERDAM COVID – 19 Declaration of Health

Please be aware that the ms Westerdam, has been inspected by this office on multiple occasions since its arrival in Sihanoukville, Kingdom of Cambodia and in all respects has been found to be free of any signs of COVID – 19. Furthermore, it has been confirmed by the Institut Pasteur du Cambodge (IPC) using World Health Organization approved protocols that all crew members onboard the ms Westerdam have been tested and found to be negative for presence of COVID - 19.

Samples taken via nasopharyngeal and/or oropharyngeal swabs between February 18 and February 19 local time by Cambodian Health Authorities and reviewed by the local US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention office in Phnom Penh, **tested NEGATIVE for COVID-19**. The test used real-time polymerase chain reaction assay protocols developed by La Charite Hospital, Virology Department, Berlin, Germany and University of Hong Kong for the determination of COVID-19 infection; both protocols are posted on the website of the World Health Organization.

No additional precautions are required for any crew who meet all applicable IATA health standards established for travel in and through all operating airports and ports worldwide. No crew member has visited or transited through Mainland China in the last 14 days which was confirmed by a thorough passport review of all crew members on Westerdam. The only person allegedly showing sign of COVID – 19 debarked the vessel on 11:57am 14 February local time.

Individuals in possession of this letter are crew members of the ms Westerdam. Any others falsely representing themselves as such will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
