It is a relatively simple modeling exercise about dynamic control interventions with intermittent reductions of R below 1. We illustrative the effect of such interventions for 16 countries with different ICU capacities.

Dear All,

We have just completed a manuscript on contact patterns after the lockdown measures in the Netherlands. The setup is slightly different from the Ipsos surveys we have in this project. We use the random sample of the population, as used in serological studies, to ask a retrospective question about number of contacts and their ages. We have also done a similar study with a similar question in the same population in 2017. This set up allows us to have a complete age range, and a good baseline. The conclusions are more or less in line with the earlier findings in the UK.

I am emailing this to you to see if this manuscript could count as output of the EpiPose project. We would like to submit it as soon as possible and would appreciate a quick response, please let us know today if you object.
