Hi (10)(2e) as you probably know, Edinburgh (10)(2e) is currently preparing a proposal, called 'PROMISE', as a follow-up to RESCEU. We were asked to participate, see formal invitation below. In the proposed WP2 of PROMISE, the idea was that participating public health institutes (RIVM, THL: (10)(2e), SSI: (10)(2e))

would take the lead in the tasks. A first outline was prepared by (10)(2e) see attachment ((10)(2e) will send an update tomorrow).

The problem is that time is very short (deadline 14 August), key staff is on holiday and RIVM, THL, SSI really do not have the capacity to take the lead in all the tasks and come up with some text in the next week.

I am just probing whether Nivel would be interested to join as a partner in the project, and take the lead in one or more of the tasks. This is supported by (10)(2e) but we have not yet discussed with (10)(2e)

I think that Nivel would be in a good position to play a role, especially with respect to surveillance activities, with track-record as coordinator of EISN, until this was handed over to ECDC.
