Yesterday, our new minister has visited Intravacc and the facilities in Bilthoven. The minister has been brought up to date on the role that intravacc can play as a translational institute in vaccine development. It has also been explained how Intravacc can contribute to the development of a covid vaccine. Finally, he had a tour of the labs and facilities. We are also working with FDI to elaborate agreements on the purchase and safeguarding of public interests in the longer term. Somewhere in June we will discuss this further with the minister.
