Subject: wrap up of TC with SANTE on next SGPP meetings

Dear all,

Thank you to those who tried to join the call earlier today (for some it failed as the skype link didn't work well, unfortunately).
 Below is a draft wrap-up of the call, which addressed both the Cancer Report and the other topics for the next 2 SGPP meetings (of 10 Sept and 2 October).

And as things go in high speed as always, we were asked to have an extra call with SANTE and the JRC tomorrow 13-14 hrs CET. If some are able to join, then that's appreciated, and otherwise I'll send an update afterwards, as now. The link to the call is attached.

Purpose of that TC tomorrow is to explore if we will be able to support the JRC in their analysis of MS responses on another survey, namely one asking MS about their future priorities for the EU4Health Programme 2021-2027 (which will be the second topic on the agenda for the 10 September meeting). The JRC itself is able to analyse the closed questions of the 13 MS responses so far but they may need our support in analyzing the open questions.

The survey they used is attached (and available at <https://ec.europa.eu/eusurvey/runner/SGPPsurvey2020>). As I can tell the only open questions are only about providing examples for each of the topic areas, so not the most complicated in nature (unless their responses are quite diverse and extensive).

As for timing it's best to distinguish between both aspects of the SGPP meeting:

- we are asked to provide an update on the Cancer report plus a one pager with guiding questions by 1 September. I will revert back to (10)(2e) in particular on that part.
- For the EU4Health priority analysis we would then have the remainder of that week, in preparation for the 10 September meeting. To divide the work, SANTE offered that they would then draft the one pager for that agenda point, which we then don't need to provide ourselves (also as that one pager needs to be send round by 1 or 2 September already). I want to ask if any RIVM and RSCI colleagues (e.g. (10)(2e) ?) would be available to advise on that survey as well, also as it's a broader topic area than cancer, but more on helping set the agenda for the EU4Health Programme 2021-2027, relevant for us all.

Evaluation SGPP meeting 27 July

- DG Minutes are now under review within Commission and will be circulated among MS after approval

Preparations SGPP meeting 10 September 09.30-12.30 hrs:

- Agenda point 1: Europe Beating Cancer Plan:
 - EUHealthSupport has sent an updated draft of the survey report and the Cancer Team will provide feedback over the next days, also on how to best make use of the national documents sent by a limited set of MS.
 - By 1 September EUHealthSupport will update the report for circulation to SGPP members, incorporating the extra survey responses from 4 MS, bringing the current total to 19 MS responses.
 - EUHealthSupport will send a list of MS that have not yet responded, which may then receive a dedicated reminder message from DG SANTE. *Note. The exact deadline to respond by MS has not yet been determined and can best be assessed in alignment with the Cancer Team on when the report needs to be finalised.*
 - A general invitation message to the 10 September SGPP meeting may contain a call to MS that have not responded, asking for their feedback in writing or during the SGPP meeting. *Note. Potentially, the message may also refer to the opportunity of SGPP members inviting extra content experts for both this and the next agenda point, in addition to their own presence at the meeting.*
 - By 1 September EUHealthSupport will draft a One Pager with guiding questions for MS. *Note. It is considered preferable not to refer to the potential establishment of a subgroup of the SGPP, as this was already addressed in the previous meeting.*
 - At the 10 September meeting EUHealthSupport will provide a presentation on the survey responses, followed by a discussion with MS. In addition, DG RTD will provide an update on the Mission on Cancer Board meeting with MS delegates on 4 September especially given the synergies between initiatives.
- Agenda point 2: Implementation of best practices and research results:
 - The agenda point was previously addressed in the January SGPP meeting, and the JRC has prepared a short survey to collect MS priorities. (10)(2e) provides a status update based on the 13 responses received so far.
 - Preliminary results of the SGPP priority survey are to be presented at the 10 September meeting. As the results are not yet available, a separate call will be set up on 26 August 13 hrs CET between SANTE, JRC and EUHealthSupport to explore in what form the latter can support the analysis of survey results, including the qualitative analysis of open text fields.
 - As EUHealthSupport will likely direct attention to the survey analyses, a first draft of the One Pager for this agenda point will be prepared by DG SANTE itself, also taking into consideration the political context of the agenda point.

Preparations SGPP meeting 2 October 14.00-17.00 hrs

- As a combined meeting the number of participants of this high level meeting will easily be doubled.
- The meeting will most likely be co-chaired by DG SANTE and DG RTD, with the previous chairs having been (10)(2e) and (10)(2e)
- Exact topics are to be determined, but will most likely include an overview of the funding instruments of Horizon Europe and EU4Health and in particular the first annual work plans, if available, this to provide synergies.
- Correspondence to delegates (e.g. save the date messages) will be sent out by DG SANTE using the dedicated AGM system, also given privacy considerations. EUHealthSupport offers to provide administrative support, among others in the drafting of messages. A dedicated meeting is proposed for Friday 4 September to assess in more detail what type of support can be provided, also based on the refined agenda by that time. EUHealthSupport will send a proposed agenda for the TC beforehand.

New meetings after October 2020:

- Currently a new meeting is foreseen on Wednesday 25 November (tentative time slot 14.00-17.00 hrs)
- The next meeting that is scheduled so far is a meeting in February 2021, either online or in person.
