Health



State of play:

1. Adaptation of the ERN CPMS platform concluded
2. System is ready and in production since 19-05-2020
3. Usage is free of charge



Characteristics of the ERN-CPMS:

1. Web-based and secured by two-factor authentication login
2. GDPR compliant:
 - Consent based or vital interest based
 - Consent forms available in all EU languages
 - Only for authorized users belonging to registered hospitals
3. Almost 300 registered hospitals



Next steps for MS health authorities:

1. Appoint at least one person to be given the authorizing role
(each appointed person should create an EU-login account)
2. Communicate the details of the appointed persons (name, surname, email, and EU login) to: 5.1.2e @ec.europa.eu
3. Create a national contact point to receive requests for authorization
 - Web form, Functional mailbox
 - Other...



Next steps for appointed authorizing persons:

1. Create an EU Login account: <https://webgate.ec.europa.eu/cas/login>
(national health authority will send your contact details to be registered in the authorization system of DG SANTE)
2. Once registered in DG SANTE:
 - Receive authorization requests from national users
 - Grant/refuse authorization to use the system (simple online procedure)
