

Subject: COVID-19: verslag EU Executive Steering Group - 9 september 2020

Beste collega's,

Op woensdagochtend 9 september vond een bijeenkomst plaats van de EU Executive Steering Group (SG) on shortages of medicines caused by major events.

Hieronder volgt een terugkoppeling van hetgeen daar is besproken.

Bijeenkomst 9 september

In de bijeenkomst van 9 september werden de volgende punten besproken:

Demand forecast for ICU medicines in the EU/EEA in the context of COVID-19

- Ad hoc Working Group discusses comments on demand forecast model.
- Comments from Ireland, Spain and the Netherlands discussed.
- EU SG in general satisfied with content of reflection in terms of methodology proposed.
- Next step: pilot will be launched to see whether the data asked for is manageable by member states.
- Particular attention raised to Dutch concerns regarding the the collecting of supply and demand data: tension with antitrust rules is prevalent in other member states as well. DG Santé had understood previously that some flexibility with regard to competition laws is permissible during a crisis situation, but will explore further with DG Competition.
- Netherlands underlines that any further development of centralized collection of demand and supply data into a structure of a more permanent nature may soon reach its limits – all is based on voluntary cooperation of the parties involved.

Regulatory capacity in the network - launch of the mapping survey on the currently available and the forecasted (vaccine) expertise within the Network

• EMA will launch survey among NCAs on current and forecasted (vaccine) expertise with regard to COVID-19 – and hopes to receive feedback by 21 September 2020.

 $International\ randomized\ trial\ of\ candidate\ vaccines\ against\ COVID-19-The\ Solidarity\ Vaccines\ trial\ under\ preparation\ by\ WHO$

- EC has been asked by WHO to support solidarity vaccine trials.
- WHO has developed a scientific assessment protocol and asks the EMRN to perform a regulatory and scientific assessment of the protocol.
