



Animal health industry - Lesson learnt on APIs shortages management during COVID-19

- Tensions for VMPs mainly as a consequence of shortages at human sector
 - · deviations from veterinary to human pharma chain
 - · appropriation of vaccine manufacturing capacity
- This being said, the animal health industry did not suffer much from the crisis. The COVID-19 outbreak has demonstrated sector resilience, animal health industry coped with stress and demands.
- Uncertainty in case of new outbreaks, what the issues related to access to APIs might be. Better coordination and faster reaction will be needed to ensure
 - · Treatment for animals and so public health
 - Food security





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- Recognition of being "essential" → VMPs benefited from the Green Lanes
- Regulatory flexibility for VMPs → appropriate measures for continued activity
