Subject: Vaccination certificates

Dear all,

As you know, the December European Council conclusions asked the Member States to develop “a coordinated approach to vaccination certificates”. <https://www.consilium.europa.eu/media/47296/1011-12-20-euco-conclusions-en.pdf>

At the same time, WHO has started working on vaccination certificates (and we hope that many of you applied for their call). We attach a presentation with WHO next steps on vaccination certificates that was presented on Friday to the technical SG of the eHealth Network.

At the same time, WHO also proposed a minimum dataset for COVID vaccination (attached). We had today a first meeting with the semantic SG and our semantic experts made clear that additional work is needed on this minimum dataset, including at the level of coding and standards.

However, given the political call to have a coordinated approach on vaccination certificates, the imminent vaccination campaigns, the need to record the vaccines in the same format and ensure interoperable solutions in this area, we should aim at adopting the minimum datasets for vaccination before holidays.

Let's try to have tomorrow a first discussion on this, to refine the document with the support of semantic and technical subgroup (as well as ECDC and EMA) and to adopt it in a new meeting or written procedure of the eHealth Network before holidays. The Health Security Committee is on board and will also be consulted on the datasets. The vaccination steering group, led by 5.1.2e, is also supportive to this endeavour.

We have an ambitious timetable ahead of us. However, with contact tracing apps, we managed to set up national solutions and a whole European infrastructure in a record time – so together, we can 😊
