

- I'd like to invite you to a private global convening on lessons learned regarding exposure notification technology cohosted by The Rockefeller Foundation and U.S. Digital Response. The Rockefeller Foundation is a global, science-driven philanthropy. In April, it established a <u>US Testing Solutions Group</u>, now with 28 members, to facilitate the exchange of best practices for public health authorities and public officials working to scale up pandemic testing and tracing. U.S. Digital Response is a nonpartisan effort that connects experienced, pro bono technology teams to public servants responding to the COVID-19 crisis and since forming in March, has partnered on over 100 projects with local government partners in 24 states.
- The purpose of this meeting is to assemble public health leaders from across the United States to hear directly from leaders in countries that have made progress on digital contact tracing. The goal would be to bring together the "do-ers" for a very practical 2 hour session on approaches and implementations thus far. For a lot of countries, we're still in the early phases, so we're hoping this will be the first of a three part series. We are hoping to bring together folks in a closed door setting from places that are further along

in using technology in their COVID response efforts, like countries in the EU.
