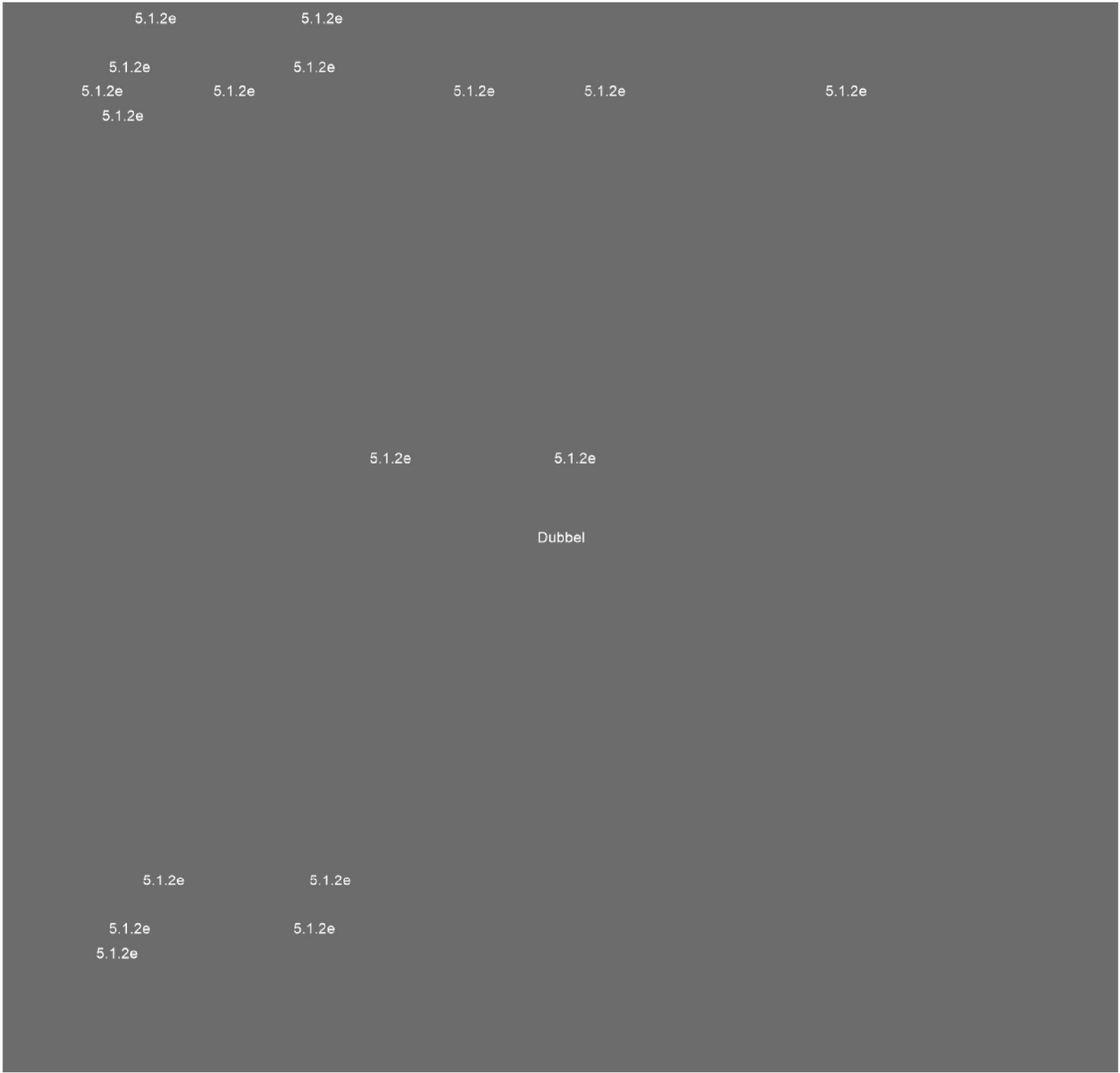

[redacted] 5.1.2e rightly pointed out that you are increasing the chance of missing a positive case as you test longer prior to departure, as chances post infection increase that a test comes out positive. So you can be a bit more quantitative concerning the risk of missing a case you would otherwise have found when allowing for a positive test 3 days before departure.
I have to ponder over this a bit longer. Will get back to you.
