Update: Since the previous RT report published on 26 September 2020 and as of 27 September 2020, 301 456 new cases of COVID-19 (in accordance with the applied case definitions and testing strategies in the affected countries) and 5 414 new deaths have been reported.

New cases have been reported from Asia (127 157), America (115 119), Europe (51 772), Africa (7 322) and Oceania (86). The five countries reporting most new cases are: India (88 600), United States (45 368), Brazil (28 378), France (14 412) and Israel (11 827).

New deaths have been reported from America (2 887), Asia (1 796), Europe (544), Africa (186) and Oceania (1). The five countries reporting most new deaths are: India (1 124), Brazil (869), United States (723), Mexico (399) and Argentina (335).

Summary: Since 31 December 2019 and as of 27 September 2020, 32 916 707 cases of COVID-19 (in accordance with the applied case definitions and testing strategies in the affected countries) have been reported, including 995 147 deaths.

Cases have been reported from:

Africa: 1 453 454 cases; the five countries reporting most cases are South Africa (669 498), Morocco (115 241), Egypt (102 736), Ethiopia (72 700) and Nigeria (58 198).

Asia: 10 131 682 cases; the five countries reporting most cases are India (5 992 532), Iran (443 086), Bangladesh (357 873), Iraq (345 969) and Saudi Arabia (332 790).
