Europe: 4 897 518 cases; the five countries reporting most cases are Russia (1 143 571), Spain (716 481), France (527 446), United Kingdom (429 277) and Italy (308 104).

Oceania: 32 839 cases; the five countries reporting most cases are Australia (27 016), Guam (2 354), New Zealand (1 477), French Polynesia (1 332) and Papua New Guinea (532).

Other: 696 cases have been reported from an international conveyance in Japan.

Deaths have been reported from:

Africa: 35 041 deaths; the five countries reporting most deaths are South Africa (16 376), Egypt (5 869), Morocco (2 041), Algeria (1 711) and Ethiopia (1 165).

Asia: 186 625 deaths; the five countries reporting most deaths are India (94 503), Iran (25 394), Indonesia (10 308), Iraq (8 935) and Turkey (7 929).

America: 550 759 deaths; the five countries reporting most deaths are United States (204 497), Brazil (141 406), Mexico (76 243), Peru (32 142) and Colombia (25 296).

Europe: 221 762 deaths; the five countries reporting most deaths are United Kingdom (41 971), Italy (35 818), France (31 700), Spain (31 232) and Russia (20 225).

Oceania: 953 deaths; the five countries reporting most deaths are Australia (870), Guam (42), New Zealand (25), Papua New Guinea (7) and French Polynesia (5).

Other: 7 deaths have been reported from an international conveyance in Japan.
