Dear receivers

For your information the government of Iceland announced today new measures at the Icelandic borders which will be enforced from 19<sup>th</sup> of august. All persons arriving to Iceland have to undergo Covid -19 test on arrival (unless if they choose to quarantine for 14 days instead), stay in mandatory quarantine for 4-6 days before taking a second test. This is to prevent false-negative results from the first test. Therefore people arriving from Faroe Island, Greenland, Norway, Germany, Denmark and Finland will no longer be exempt from the quarantine and screening requirements.
