We have been informed that an Irish resident currently in Amsterdam is a positive COVID19 case. He is due to return to Ireland tomorrow.

We have been toldd that he was tested on the 19th August 2020. The test result is positive.



We believe that 5.1.2e has been informed of his positive diagnosis while on holidays in Amsterdam.

We are contacting you to let you know that he is in your jurisdiction and is a confirmed case, we do not know if he is aware or following Dutch guidance on restriction of movement of confirmed cases, he should not travel back to Ireland tomorrow.

We request that Dutch authorities contact 5.1.2e ot inform him of your local guidance and to support the recommendations that he should not travel .

We are not sure if he is fully aware of the protocol that states that any individual with infectious disease should not travel. In Ireland it is also the responsibility of the airline to enforce this measure. You may need to share this information with the airline to ensure that they enforce and do not allow him to fly.

He is due to fly back to Ireland this evening - he should not do this.
