**Update:** Since the previous RT report published on 28 August 2020 and as of 29 August 2020, 285 834 new cases of COVID-19 (in accordance with the applied case definitions and testing strategies in the affected countries) and 5 575 new deaths have been reported.

New cases have been reported from America (137 462), Asia (103 909), Europe (36 153), Africa (8 018) and Oceania (292). The five countries reporting most new cases are: India (76 472), United States (49 654), Brazil (43 412), Argentina (10 104) and Spain (9 779).

New deaths have been reported from America (3 328), Asia (1 583), Europe (420), Africa (231) and Oceania (13). The five countries reporting most new deaths are: India (1 021), United States (949), Brazil (855), Mexico (552) and Colombia (299).

**Summary:** Since 31 December 2019 and as of 29 August 2020, 24 760 129 cases of COVID-19 (in accordance with the applied case definitions and testing strategies in the affected countries) have been reported, including 837 579 deaths.

### Cases have been reported from:

Africa: 1 229 230 cases; the five countries reporting most cases are South Africa (620 123), Egypt (98 285), Morocco (58 489), Nigeria (53 477) and Ethiopia (48 140).

Asia: 6 738 848 cases; the five countries reporting most cases are India (3 463 972), Iran (369 911), Saudi Arabia (312 924), Bangladesh (306 794) and Pakistan (295 372).

America: 13 174 448 cases; the five countries reporting most cases are United States (5 917 439), Brazil (3 804 803), Peru (629 961), Colombia (590 520) and Mexico (585 738).

Europe: 3 587 816 cases; the five countries reporting most cases are Russia (980 405), Spain (439 286), United Kingdom (331 644), France (267 077) and Italy (265 409).

**Oceania**: 29 091 cases; the five countries reporting most cases are Australia (25 448), New Zealand (1 376), Guam (1 287), Papua New Guinea (453) and French Polynesia (420).

Other: 696 cases have been reported from an international conveyance in Japan.

## Deaths have been reported from:

Africa: 29 093 deaths; the five countries reporting most deaths are South Africa (13 743), Egypt (5 362), Algeria (1 483), Morocco (1 052) and Nigeria (1 011).

Asia: 136 844 deaths; the five countries reporting most deaths are India (62 550), Iran (21 249), Indonesia (7 169), Iraq (6 814) and Pakistan (6 284).

America: 462 441 deaths; the five countries reporting most deaths are United States (181 773), Brazil (119 504), Mexico (63 146), Peru (28 471) and Colombia (18 767).

**Europe**: 208 570 deaths; the five countries reporting most deaths are United Kingdom (41 486), Italy (35 472), France (30 596), Spain (29 011) and Russia (16 914).

**Oceania**: 624 deaths; the five countries reporting most deaths are Australia (583), New Zealand (22), Guam (10), Papua New Guinea (5) and Fiji (2).

Other: 7 deaths have been reported from an international conveyance in Japan.

# EU/EEA and the UK:

As of 29 August 2020, 2 168 764 cases have been reported in the EU/EEA and the UK: Spain (439 286), United Kingdom (331 644), France (267 077), Italy (265 409), 5:1:2a Romania (84 468), Sweden (83 958), Belgium (83 858), Netherlands (69 063), Poland (65 480), Portugal (57 074), Ireland (28 579), Austria (26 763), Czechia (23 777), Denmark (16 700), Bulgaria (16 065), Norway (10 543), Greece (9 800), Croatia (9 549), Finland (8 042), Luxembourg (6 580), Hungary (5 511), Slovakia (3 728), Lithuania (2 810), Slovenia (2 797), Estonia (2 343), Iceland (2 092), Malta (1 820), Cyprus (1 481), Latvia (1 375) and Liechtenstein (106).

As of 29 August 2020, 181 531 deaths have been reported in the EU/EEA and the UK: United Kingdom (41 486), Italy (35 472), France (30 596), Spain (29 011), Belgium (9 886), 5.1.2a Netherlands (6 211), Sweden (5 821), Romania (3 507), Poland (2 018), Portugal (1 915), Ireland (1 777), Austria (733), Denmark (624), Hungary (614), Bulgaria (603), Czechia (419), Finland (335), Norway (264), Greece (259), Croatia (180), Slovenia (128), Luxembourg (124), Lithuania (86), Estonia (64), Latvia (34), Slovakia (33), Cyprus (21), Iceland (10), Malta (10) and Liechtenstein (1).

## EU:

As of 29 August 2020, 1 824 379 cases and 139 770 deaths have been reported in the EU.
