Thank you for your comments on the proposed variables to capture information on SARS-CoV-2 variants. We have now implemented these variables in TESSy for the recordtypes NCOV and NCOVAGGR. The new variables are not mandatory so if data are not available there should be no impact on your reporting. As mentioned below, we prefer if case-based data are reported (NCOV), however if these are not available please report using the aggregated dataset (NCOVAGGR).

Dear Operational Contact Points for COVID-19,

Based on the increased need to understand the spread, progression, and severity of variants of SARS-CoV-2 of public health concern, ECDC and the WHO Euro have modified both case-based and aggregate surveillance reporting for SARS-CoV-2.

ECDC has added two new variables to TESSy case-based reporting (NCOV) and six new variables to the aggregate (NCOVAGGR) reporting to capture surveillance data for cases that have been sequenced.

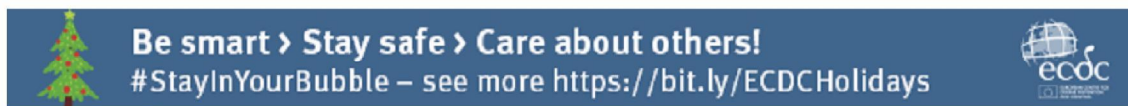
Please review the draft metadataset 47 (see attached variable extract) and reply within 24 hours if there are any major concerns.

We will update TESSy as soon as possible after considering your comments and will let you know when these changes are effective.

ECDC and WHO recommend to report these data as case-based data to allow for comparison of cases with the full dataset.

Thank you, as always, for your continued hard work as the surveillance needs of this pandemic continue to evolve over time.
