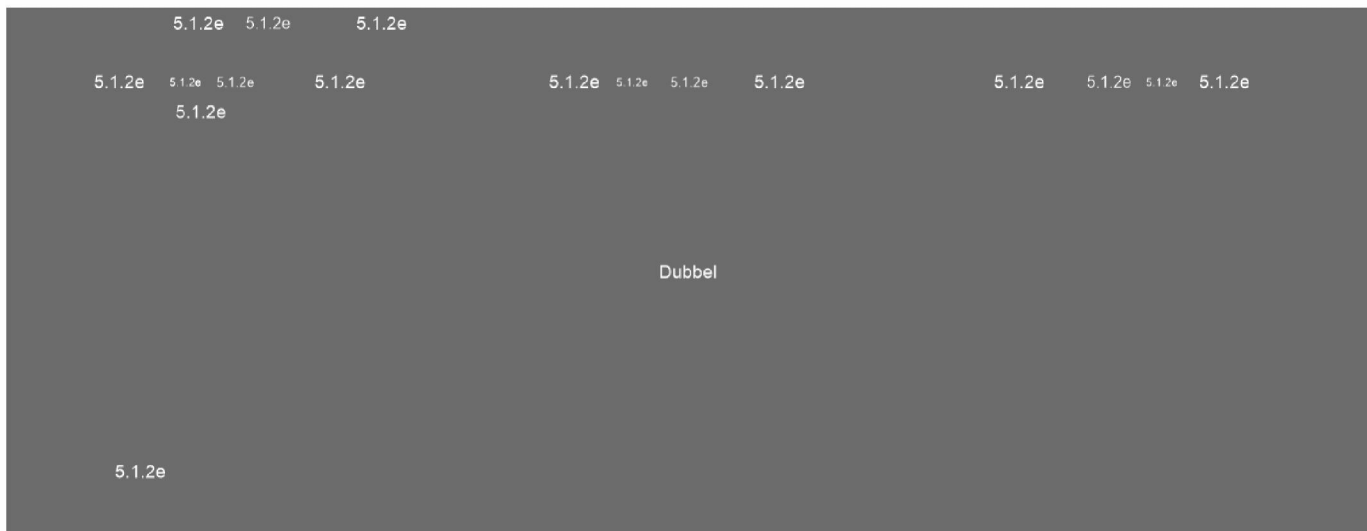
This we can accept, as long as the current provisional commitment deadline of 31.1.2021 will be moved backwards (in March).
