As for other countries, none of our team members are solely dedicated to vaccine aspects of COVID-19 outbreak, and we are all cumulating COVID-19 tasks since march 2020. In addition, daily uploads increase the risk of data issues and poorer data quality, data cleaning being less exhaustive.

ECDC role is to support the member states. In this line of thought, could you give us additional information or an explanation on the public health added value of daily vaccine numbers for the management of the COVID-19 outbreak, in comparison to twice weekly numbers? How will these be used by the EC? Indeed, with the information received thus far, we cannot see any justified added value of this additional task.

In addition for us, there will be a problem on weekends as this will demand the person who is responsible uploading the data to work non-stop 7 days a week every week.

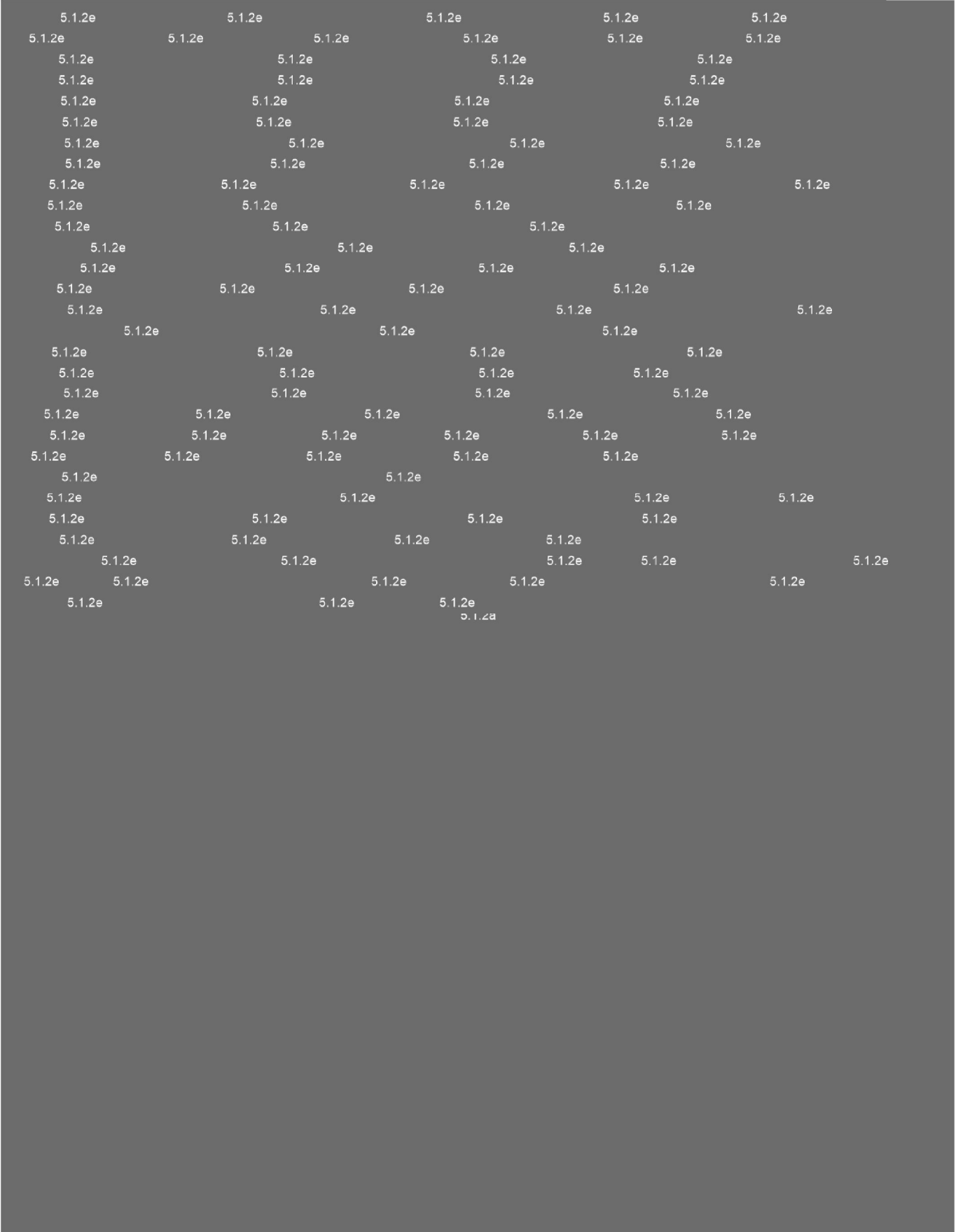
We believe that the already established, Tuesday and Friday uploading, is more reasonable.
