Dear colleagues,

We would like to thank you for all the efforts you have made to collect and report vaccine data to [5.1.2a]. This data will be vital to allow monitoring progress on the roll-out of COVID19 vaccination across the EU/EEA.

The [Vaccine Tracker](#) is online since yesterday morning with a limited number of data and indicators presented. A second version of the tracker will be published in two weeks' time and will include additional data on the administration of the second dose and among target groups.

The Vaccine Tracker has been already attracting, as expected, considerable media attention and ECDC is receiving a number of questions on country-specific data reported, incl. discrepancies observed with nationally reported/published data. We thus encourage you all to help us regularly improve the accuracy and reliability of information provided to give an accurate picture of your respective national situation.

). We are also currently approaching some of you individually to clarify some discrepancies or incorrect data.

The Vaccine Tracker will be updated in "real time" when data are updated or uploaded in the system. Thus, any new submissions/corrections received from you will be implemented into the Tracker as soon as possible. Every Monday a snapshot of the tracker will be taken and the report will be shared with the European Commission.

In addition to the Vaccine Tracker, the data is also meant to be published in a weekly report (HTML format enclosed).
We kindly ask you to review the attached draft report and to provide feedback on its content and on the data from your country (report produced with most recent data submitted as of today 14.45), by Thursday, 4 February lunch time (1 pm).

The attached report is expected to be in the public domain from Tuesday next week.
