Update: Since the previous RT report published on 08 March 2020 and as of 9 March 2020, 3 872 new cases of COVID-19 (in accordance with the applied case definitions in the affected countries) and 227 new deaths have been reported. Two countries have reported cases for the first time: Albania and Bangladesh.

New cases have been reported from Italy (1 492), Iran (743), France (410), South Korea (248), Spain (159), United States (121), Netherlands (77), Switzerland (68), United Kingdom (67), Germany (55), China (45), Sweden (42), Egypt (34), Japan (33), Belgium (31), Norway (22), Bahrain (16), Israel (14), Brazil (12), Singapore (12), Finland (11), San Marino (11), Lebanon (10), Vietnam (9), Portugal (9), Iraq (8), Denmark (7), Greece (7), Peru (6), Malaysia (6), Czech Republic (6), Australia (6), Canada (5), Chile (5), Poland (5), Costa Rica (4), Philippines (4), Saudi Arabia (4), Slovenia (4), Algeria (3), Argentina (3), Bangladesh (3), Kuwait (3), Qatar (3), Austria (3), Mexico (2), Indonesia (2), Maldives (2), Albania (2), Bulgaria (2), Iceland (2), Ireland (2), Luxembourg (2), Romania (2), Slovakia (2), Cameroon (1), South Africa (1), Ecuador (1), Georgia (1), Hungary (1) and Latvia (1).

New deaths have been reported from Italy (133), Iran (49), China (23), France (9), United States (4), Iraq (2), Netherlands (2), Egypt (1), Japan (1), South Korea (1), Switzerland (1) and the United Kingdom (1).

Major developments in the EU/EEA and the UK:

Italy: Italy: Peported 7 375 cases of COVID-19 and 366 deaths. This is an increase of 1 492 cases and 133 deaths since yesterday.

France: France reported 1 126 cases of COVID-19 and 19 deaths. This is an increase of 410 cases and nine deaths since yesterday.

Germany: Germany reported 902 cases of COVID-19 and no deaths. This is an increase of 55 cases since yesterday.

Spain: Spain reported 589 cases of COVID-19 and five deaths. This is an increase of 159 cases since yesterday.

United Kingdom: The UK reported 273 cases of COVID-19 and three deaths. This is an increase of 67 cases and one death since yesterday.

Other updates:

Albania: Albanian authorities reported the first two cases of COVID-19. Both cases have a travel history to Italy.

Bangladesh: Authorities reported the first three cases of COVID-19.

Egypt: Authorities reported 49 cases of COVID-19 and the first death. According to media, the death is a German tourist.

Summary: Since 31 December 2019 and as of 9 March 2020, 109 695 cases of COVID-19 (in accordance with the applied case definitions in the affected countries) have been reported, including 3 811 deaths. The deaths have been reported from China (3 122), Italy (366), Iran (194), South Korea (51), United States (21), France (19), Japan (7), an international conveyance in Japan (6), Spain (5), Îraq (4), Australia (3), Netherlands (3), United Kingdom (3), Switzerland (2), Argentina (1), Egypt (1), San Marino (1), Taiwan (1) and Thailand (1).

Cases have been reported on the following continents:

Africa: Egypt (49), Algeria (20), Senegal (4), South Africa (3), Cameroon (2), Morocco (2), Nigeria (1), Togo (1) and Tunisia (1).

Asia: China (80 859), South Korea (7 382), Iran (6 566), Japan (488), Singapore (150), Malaysia (99), Bahrain (79), Kuwait (64), Iraq (62), Thailand (50), Taiwan (45), United Arab Emirates (45), Israel (39), India (34), Lebanon (32), Vietnam (30), Palestine* (19), Oman (16), Qatar (15), Saudi Arabia (11), Philippines (10), Indonesia (6), Pakistan (6), Afghanistan (4), Maldives (4), Bangladesh (3), Cambodia (2), Bhutan (1), Jordan (1), Nepal (1) and Sri Lanka (1).

America: United States Of America (554), Canada (62), Brazil (25), Ecuador (14), Argentina (12), Chile (10), Mexico (7), Peru (7), Costa Rica (5), Dominican Republic (2), Colombia (1) and Paraguay (1).

Europe: Italy (7 375), France (1 126), Germany (902), Spain (589), Switzerland (332), United Kingdom (273), Netherlands (265), Sweden (203), Belgium (200), Norway (169), Austria (102), Greece (73), Iceland (55), Denmark (38), San Marino (37), Czech Republic (32), Finland (30), Portugal (30), Ireland (21), Slovenia (16), Romania (15), Georgia (13), Croatia (12), Poland (11), Estonia (10), Russia (10), Azerbaijan (9), Hungary (8), Belarus (6), Luxembourg (5), Slovakia (5), Bulgaria (4), Latvia (3), Malta (3), North Macedonia (3), Albania (2), Bosnia And Herzegovina (2), Andorra (1), Armenia (1), Holy See Vatican City State (1), Liechtenstein (1), Lithuania (1), Moldova (1), Monaco (1), Serbia (1) and Ukraine (1).

Oceania: Australia (80) and New Zealand (5).

Other: International conveyance in Japan (705).

* This designation shall not be construed as recognition of a State of Palestine and is without prejudice to the individual positions of the Member States on this issue.

EU/EEA and the UK:

As of 9 March 2020, 11 577 cases have been reported in the EU/EEA and the UK: Italy (7 375), France (1 126), Germany (902), Spain (589), United Kingdom (273), Netherlands (265), Sweden (203), Belgium (200), Norway (169), Austria (102), Greece (73), Iceland (55), Denmark (38), Czech Republic (32), Finland (30), Portugal (30), Ireland (21), Slovenia (16), Romania (15), Croatia (12), Poland (11), Estonia (10), Hungary (8), Luxembourg (5), Slovakia (5), Bulgaria (4), Latvia (3), Malta (3), Liechtenstein (1) and Lithuania (1).

As of 9 March 2020, 396 deaths have been reported in the EU/EEA and the UK: Italy (366), France (19), Spain (5), Netherlands (3) and the United Kingdom (3).

Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC):

On 30 January 2020, the World Health Organization declared that the outbreak of COVID-19 constitutes a PHEIC.
