

COVID-19 associated with SARS-CoV-2 - multi-country (world) - 2020

Update: Since the previous RT report published on 10 March 2020 and as of 11 March 2020, 4 385 new cases of COVID-19 (in accordance with the applied case definitions in the affected countries) and 269 new deaths have been reported. 2 countries have reported cases for the first time: Burkina Faso and the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

New deaths have been reported from Italy (167), Iran (54), China (22), Spain (7), South Korea (6), Japan (3), France (3), United States (2), Panama (1), Lebanon (1), Netherlands (1), Switzerland (1) and United Kingdom (1).

Summary: Since 31 December 2019 and as of 11 March 2020, 118 629 cases of COVID-19 (in accordance with the applied case definitions in the affected countries) have been reported, including 4 292 deaths. The deaths have been reported from China (3 161), Italy (631), Iran (291), South Korea (60), Spain (35), France (33), United States (28), Japan (12), International conveyance in Japan (7), Iraq (6), United Kingdom (6), Netherlands (4), Australia (3), Switzerland (3), Germany (2), San Marino (2), Argentina (1), Canada (1), Egypt (1), Lebanon (1), Panama (1), Philippines (1), Taiwan (1)

and Thailand (1).

Cases have been reported on the following continents:
