I am a bit confused by your conclusion that "30% is acceptable and 3 months should also be acceptable" as my offer consisted of two parts: 30% in combination with 2 months. Two months for us is the maximum period acceptable; an extension to 3 months brings us - because of the organisation of our financial system - into insurmountable administrative problems. I am sure you will understand this as we have also encountered this kind of situations in the past in relation to EMA's financial regulations.

I do understand your arguments in favor of 3 months, however, I am confident that we should be able to solve the issues well before end November. However, if not, we should avoid the risk of running into a formal dispute according to the lease agreement and include an evaluation moment at our level first.

I hope that with this explanation you agree with my earlier text proposal of March 2nd. Please let me know!
