Dear colleagues

Following a wave of reports from patients and clinicians about rapid onset smell loss, health organizations throughout the world have recognized anosmia as a marker for the **COVID-19**, even in the absence of other symptoms. Scientists worldwide have united as the Global Consortium of Chemosensory Researchers (GCCR) to investigate the connection between the

chemical senses and **COVID-19**. The GCCR is a group of more than 500 clinicians, neurobiologists, data scientists, cognitive scientists, sensory researchers and technicians from 38 countries. I am country leader for the Netherlands. The GCCR will use data collected in a worldwide survey to unravel how the virus is transmitted and how to prevent its spread. The survey will be translated to more than 20 languages (including Dutch) and available to individuals and clinicians on the GCCR website.
