Roughly the details: Businesses can apply if they are able to produce in Germany and deliver the first charge before the 15th of August, application deadline was April 7th. They also have to be able to deliver a certain minimum quantity which is (100.000

masks/week and 10.000 gowns/week).

The businesses will be picked with regard to the price they are able to offer. Germany, represented by the Federal Ministry of Health (who is the contract-partner) will pick at least 2 and max. 100 businesses per item (item 1: FFP2-masks, item 2: OP-masks and item 3: gowns) to reach the **maximum purchase quantity** which is 5-10 Mio FFP2-masks/week, 20-40 Mio. OP-masks/week and 1 Mio. gowns/week. Contracts that have been made within this procurement procedure are to last until the end of 2021.


