In the European part of the Netherlands we have had a few quiet months, but cases have been on the rise in the last few weeks again. In the Caribbean parts we have worries about Aruba and Sint Maarten in particular, with many cases and hospitalizations. Bonaire/Saba/Statia have been quiet, luckily.

At the moment we are sending patients from the BES mainly to Aruba and Curacao, and sometimes to Martinique. It is good to hear that Colombia is slowly coming back in business. However, for the moment we have not made any decisions to change the destination of our patients (elective and acute).

I do not know what the future will bring, but lets keep each other informed.

Hope everything is going well with you and the health situation in the Netherlands and the islands is improving.

Colombia is coming back for business gradually including air travel with national flights between the main cities including Bogota and Medellin, today the government also announced that in the upcoming couple of weeks, international flights will be allowed to fly in and out of the country. Also, elective medical care in clinics and hospitals different to Covid-19 and appointments with specialists are permitted as of tomorrow.

On the other hand, I wanted to let you know that I have been in contact with Clinica Las Americas and Fundaciòn San Vicente and they are ready to collaborate once you resume patient referrals to Colombia. I have included in my team some of the people that used to work with Coomeva, so we acquire more capabilities and expertise.

We signed a contract with ING (IGS for Latam) which is basically a 24/7 contact center with different medical specialties attend by GPs and Specialists in different areas for their assistance program. In addition to that we are able to arrange through different provider charter flights to bring patients from the islands for those in need of critical care with some of our partners once the government opens this type of services, which we expect is going to be very soon.
