Dear colleagues

We would like to warmly thank you for the effort you have put so far in reporting timely data on the COVID-19 vaccine rollout to TESSy. All EU/EEA Member States are submitting timely on their data and the quality has improved a lot. This is a huge achievement.

We can now provide a good overview at EU/EEA level of your national data on the total number of vaccines distributed to Member States by the manufacturers and the number of doses administered to the adult population, as well as estimates for the uptake of the first vaccine dose and full vaccination (i.e. 2 doses for vaccine products currently available) among adults.

Currently, your data is being processed as follows:

• Data are refreshed daily in the ECDC Vaccine Tracker (<u>https://qap.ecdc.europa.eu/public/extensions/COVID-19/vaccine-tracker.html#uptake-tab</u>)

• A weekly overview report is published every Thursday with data as of the previous week (<u>https://covid19-vaccine-report.ecdc.europa.eu/#Vaccine_rollout_summary</u>).

What will happen next?

• A third version of the Tracker will be released next week with information on trends in vaccine uptake. Country profiles with an overview of key indicators of the vaccine rollout will also be displayed.

• Some vaccine data will be included in a joint WHO/ECDC bulletin that is expected to be issued on 19 March 2021

• A request for nomination to identify dedicated Operational Contact Points (OCP) for Covid-19 Vaccination (Epidemiology and TESSy) will be launched in the coming days

Where we need a bit of further attention :

• We still need to work together to improve the reporting of data disaggregated by detailed age groups and in both healthcare workers (HCW) and residents of long-term care facilities (LTCF). For some countries, data on the numerator and/or the denominator for these target groups are still missing. In its communication on the 19th of January 2021, the EC set key targets of fully vaccinating 80% of the elderly (aged 80+) and HCW by the end of March 2021. Considering that the deadline of these targets is approaching, we would like to provide a more comprehensive overview of the rollout in these specific subgroups. We kindly ask you to upload available data by age groups and in HCW/LTCF, as well as the denominators for these subgroups, in your next reporting, or as soon as available.

• This communication is also to inform you that we are proposing a change in the reporting timeline, currently twice a week every Tuesday and Friday. We propose to keep the data reporting twice a week, but updating the days of reporting

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to Tuesday and Thursday (instead of Tuesday and Friday). Data uploaded on Tuesday will be published every Thursday in the ECDC weekly report on the COVID-19 vaccine rollout overview (the report reflects the status of vaccine rollout as of the previous week). Any major corrections of the data uploaded on Thursday will be addressed on Friday. Of course, we encourage that data be reported as often as possible in order to keep the data in the Tracker as timely and accurate as possible. The updated version of the reporting protocol (V1.5) will be available into TESSy (and is also attached). Please let us know if this change in reporting schedule is not convenient.
