Urgentie: Hoog

Dear All,

I am excited and delighted to let you know that on this Tuesday March 16th we are going to vaccinate our 4.000th person on Sint Maarten!

My excitement comes from the fact that we will achieve this important benchmark on our 17th day of vaccination, with an average of 235 vaccinations per day.

We are now vaccinating at a faster speed than the number of persons registering for vaccination and are able to considerably scale up daily vaccinations.

If registration continues at the current rate we will not be able to achieve herd immunity (by vaccinating 70% of the population) before August 2021.

For your information, at present we are vaccinating Priority Groups I (Medical Front Line Workers), II (60 years and older) and III (age 18 – 59 with underlying conditions).

I am in continuous discussion with our counterparts in The Netherlands about the possibility to also vaccinate Priority Groups IV (Essential Workers) and V (age 18 – 59 without underlying conditions).

Naturally I will keep you informed as well as I possibly can.

I attach a presentation that gives you a broad overview of the status of the Vaccination Campaign.
