Dear members of the Health Security Committee, Dear colleagues,

As presented yesterday at the HSC meeting, next week, the Commission will adopt a framework on vaccination, testing and recovery certificates. Regarding the **data elements to be included in COVID-19 test certificates**, the common standardised set of data that is presented in Annex II of the <u>document agreed by the HSC on 17 February</u> forms the basis for this.

The eHealth Network has reviewed this Annex, and has put forward suggestions how to further refine it. It mainly concerns inclusion of additional details in the column 'preferred code system' and clarifications in terms of data to be included (inclusion of additional elements rather than descriptive text). The suggested changes to the data elements are in line with the text that is currently included in the draft Regulation.

Please review the attached document with suggested changes to Annex II and let us know by **COB today** in case you have any comments. If no comments are received, we will consider this update to be agreed by the HSC by written procedure and the updated document will be published on Friday.

Finally, for info, soon we will launch a process to update the other parts of this HSC document (the RAT common list and the mutually agreed RAT list), as several of you have requested to add rapid antigen tests. We will contact you about this in a separate email next week.
