Proposal for a REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL amending Regulation (EC) No 851/2004 establishing a European Centre for disease prevention and control



- rapid digitalisation of integrated surveillance systems;
- <u>develop prevention and response plans</u> against future epidemics and stronger <u>capacities</u> for integrated rapid epidemic and outbreak response;
- provision of <u>non-binding recommendations</u> for risk management;
- reinforced capacity and building key competences to monitor and assess health systems capacity;
- reinforced capacity to <u>identify population groups at risk</u> and in need of targeted prevention and response measures;
- linking research and preparedness and response;
- coordination of a <u>new network of Union reference laboratories</u> for public health;
- expanding work on the prevention of communicable diseases and specific health issues;
- reinforcing the contribution to the EU's international cooperation and development and EU commitment to global health security preparedness.
