Dear HSC secretariat,

Thank you for providing the draft report. We would like to make a small adjustment on page 3 (agenda point 3 – certificate for persons recovered from COVID-19). The Netherlands did not advocate for a conservative approach in general, this was related to the proposed timeframe.

The timeframe we currently use for a positive test result is; minimum of 2 weeks old and maximum of 8 weeks old. We currently only use such a policy for people who test positive for COVID-19 for a prolonged period of time after infection (and who are therefore not able to comply to the negative test certificate required for incoming travellers).
