PHRI has been approached by ELIXIR for a call within the Horizon Europe – Work Programme 2021-2022 (HORIZON-INFRA-EOSC-2021-01-06: FAIR and open data sharing in support of European preparedness for infectious diseases). ELIXIR (together with EMBL-EBI, ESFRI research infrastructures in life science and social sciences and other partners with expertise in public health and health data federation) intends to submit a response to this request.

The aim of the project is to deliver a federated ecosystem where national centers, individual researchers and European networks expose and integrate data resources in line with FAIR principles and the European Open Science Cloud. This will be achieved via a common mechanism for data indexing, and links to the COVID-19 data platform (www.covid19dataportal.org) that recognizes and extends the established metadata standards and registries in each of the domains. A set of use cases will provide examples on the utility.

We have drafted a use case on the interaction of viral genome profile and severity of the COV-19 disease and vaccination efficacy. I have attached a (very!) short description of the call and the potential use cases, describing the tasks for data hubs when participating in these use case.
