I don't see a problem.

- a. We can agree bilaterally outside the MTA that they can use the material for EQA panels within country. "The RECIPIENT agrees to refer to the EVA-GLOBAL PARTNER any request for the MATERIAL from anyone other than those persons working under the RECIPIENT SCIENTIST's direct supervision."
- b. 24 months: we can change that how we like, so we can agree for them to maintain it in their collection.
- c. Ok, indicate ok and that we would appreciate to be acknowledged in any manuscript using the strain.

So change the date to indefinitely. Add that we can agree bilaterally, outside the MTA, for use for national capacity building. Official request to me by e-mail.

We have now reviewed the MTA and we wish to add a few changes.  
Please find the new version attached for your evaluation.

In brief:

- 1) We would very much like to incorporate this isolate in our virus collection, and wish therefore not to destruct the material. Would this be possible?
- 2) As a national reference lab, we provide positive controls to SARS-CoV-2 test centers and hospitals at no charge. Could this agreement cover such an activity (inactivated virus material only)?
- 3) Finally, we would like to use the material in our basic research, evaluating the immune response against virus infections as well as vaccines (ours and others').  
The material itself would not be used as a vaccine or vaccine component.

Looking forward to hearing from you and please let me know if you have any questions.  
And thank you for accepting a signed pdf version in advance to speed up things.
