Indeed, the legal name of the applicant is the same (Ministerie van Volksgezondheid, Welzijn en Sport) – but I see the contact persons belong to two different institutions: the **Ministry of Health** for the 1st request and the **Rijksinstituut voor Volksgezondheid en Milieu (RIVM)**. For the Rijksinstituut voor Volksgezondheid en Milieu (RIVM), a Financial Identification form was also sent and the bank account is different than for the 1st request. If all requests are grouped in one grant agreement, as we initially intended, there can only be one bank account. If not, we would have to have separate grants.

This is not actually visible in the documents you submitted and if this is confirmed by you, they would need to be amended. In such a case, the total cost in the grant application form is only a fraction of the cost of the plane; therefore, you would need to revise each grant application and add the following details:

- the percentage of the volume of the total cargo for the assistance sent
- the total cost of the plane
