Consent to national registration by RIVM

If you agree, your GP will pass on some information about your vaccination to RIVM. This is important for your safety, for research to see if the vaccine works effectively, and to decide whether measures can be relaxed when vaccination coverage reaches sufficiently high levels. You can also be alerted quickly in the event of any side-effects, for example.

After vaccination, you will be given a registration card with information about the vaccine you received. You can use this card again for the second vaccination. If your details have been passed on to RIVM, you can request a copy of your registration card from RIVM later.

Which data is stored?

RIVM registers the following data: your citizen service number (BSN, date of birth, first and last name, your address, reason for vaccination (age, medical condition or care worker), date and location where you received the vaccination, name of the vaccine and batch ID.

Please state whether you consent for your GP to share this information with RIVM. You can indicate this on the invitation sent by your GP. Your choice will not affect your vaccination. The vaccine will be administered even if you do not give permission for the information to be shared with RIVM.

Please note: Bring the invitation from your GP with you to your vaccination appointment.

Data retention

RIVM will in principle retain your vaccination records for 20 years, in accordance with the law. This may be shorter or longer if necessary for the purposes of registration as described above. Only a small number of people will be able to view your personal details. These are the people who implement the vaccination programme or who are required to alert you if something has gone wrong. For policy-related and statistical purposes, the data is anonymised. You can have your personal data deleted from the RIVM register at any time. This can be done easily at mijn.rivm.nl/vaccinaties. You will need your DigiD for this purpose.
