Bon dia, as of **29 December 2020, from 00.01 hrs, all passengers, including Dutch nationals**, must have a **negative PCR test declaration** in order to board an aircraft for travel to the Netherlands.

Customers that fly to The Netherlands from high-risk areas must be in possession of a negative PCR test result before boarding. **The test must have been done no more than 72 hours before the scheduled arrival of the customer in The Netherlands.**
