Input NL:

- In response to the newly emerging Covid-19 mutation on December 19th, the National Institute for Public Health of the NL has advised to take measures to restrict travel from the UK to the Netherlands.
- The NL has decided to ban all air travel, with the exception of cargo, from the UK, from December 20th 6am (UK time) till January 1st 2021.
- In addition, the NL has decided to ban all shipping (passengers) from the UK to the Dutch ports till January 1st 2021. Shipping traffic of goods are exempted from this ban.
- Currently, we are exploring additional measures to also restrict travel by transportation means other than air and water.
- During the IPCR, NL will call on to other MS to coordinate, where possible, a strict ban until at least the first of January and request a negative test result for all travellers (including employees of transport organizations) and, with , for all modes of transport, without exemptions.
- Furthermore, NL requests other MS to think about possible coordinated measures for after January.
