Following discussions with DG SANTE, DG ECHO and several Member States, I am writing to you to request a meeting to discuss medical stockpiling and rapid deployment solutions as crucial instruments to increase European preparedness and health system resilience.

It's Philips' view that effective and sustainable stockpiling of medical technologies should focus on ensuring the availability of needed medical equipment and services along the care continuum — serving to protect citizens from the shortages and supply chain vulnerabilities exposed in the COVID-19 pandemic. 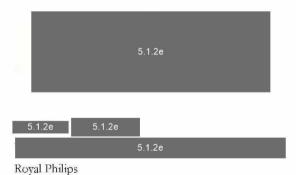
