Our speakers raised very interesting points, and what we have learned and need to take as take home messages from this workshop are:

- A common European approach is needed for points of entry and air, sea and ground transport sectors operating internationally. This involves cooperation and coordination when responding to events, including a common digitized PLF for EUM (<u>5.1.2e</u>), as well as cooperation and coordination of efforts for safely restarting transport sector activities and lifting restrictive measures at internal borders and allowing connections with third countries
- \mathfrak{P}^{\perp} For an effective response strong collaboration between the health sector with other stakeholders in the transport sector is very important (5.1.2e).
- 9[⊥] Also, to deal with new unexpected challenges, flexibility of public health authorities is important in order to be able to adapt and modify timely the response plans when needed.
- ¹ Human resources and points of entry were the two areas that most countries worldwide had declared to WHO low capacities before the COVID-19 pandemic and as we have seen in the presentation of the survey results from 5.1.2e and also 5.1.2e highlighted, the pandemic revealed the necessity to focus, invest and improve those areas in the future
