Dear members of the EU scientific advice platform on COVID-19,

In view of tomorrow's meeting at 17:00 (CET), please find attached:

- Draft report from your previous meeting on 13/11 - Any comments are welcome until Tuesday
- Agenda for tomorrow's meeting
- Background document 1 - Overview of quarantines, isolation and travel related quarantines
- Background document 2 - ECDC review of different practices

These background documents aim at facilitating the discussion and are not published.

Please note that Commissioner Kyriakides would like to focus the discussion around two key questions:

- The ECDC and WHO currently recommend a 14-day quarantine (shortened to 10 days with a negative PCR test taken on the 10th day). For the countries that implemented shorter quarantines, based on which criteria did you design your approach? Have you monitored the impact of shorter quarantines and what are the findings? Are they leading to increased compliance?
- ECDC does not recommend quarantine for travel in the current epidemiological situation, though most EU countries do. What are the reasons for having quarantines for travellers in place? Is there a willingness to reach an EU wide approach on this issue?
