I hope you've had a lovely weekend. Thank you for sending us the link for testing the survey last week – this was very useful. Find below some remarks and in the Excel sheet attached more specific changes after going through the online survey.

Demographic questions

Regarding all the questions on demographics; do you have these available for the Dutch context, possibly still from the first CoMix study in the Netherlands? More specifically, this refers to the questions on where the respondent lives, education, occupation, profession, etc. (they are specified in the Excel sheet)? It would be good once we start testing the actual Dutch survey to have such questions from the first wave incorporated in the script. Also, may I assume changing these questions to the Dutch context will not be counted in the max. 15% changes we are allowed to make?

Budget and sample size

When looking at the budget, we have consulted internally and would like to go for option B. However, we were wondering if it would be possible for IPSOS to start the sample with 200 people per age group (18-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69, 70+) and 150 people for the younger age groups that parents will fill in for them (0-12, 13-17)? This is because we could see the panel from the first wave is not representative in terms of age groups, so it would be good to try and correct for this.

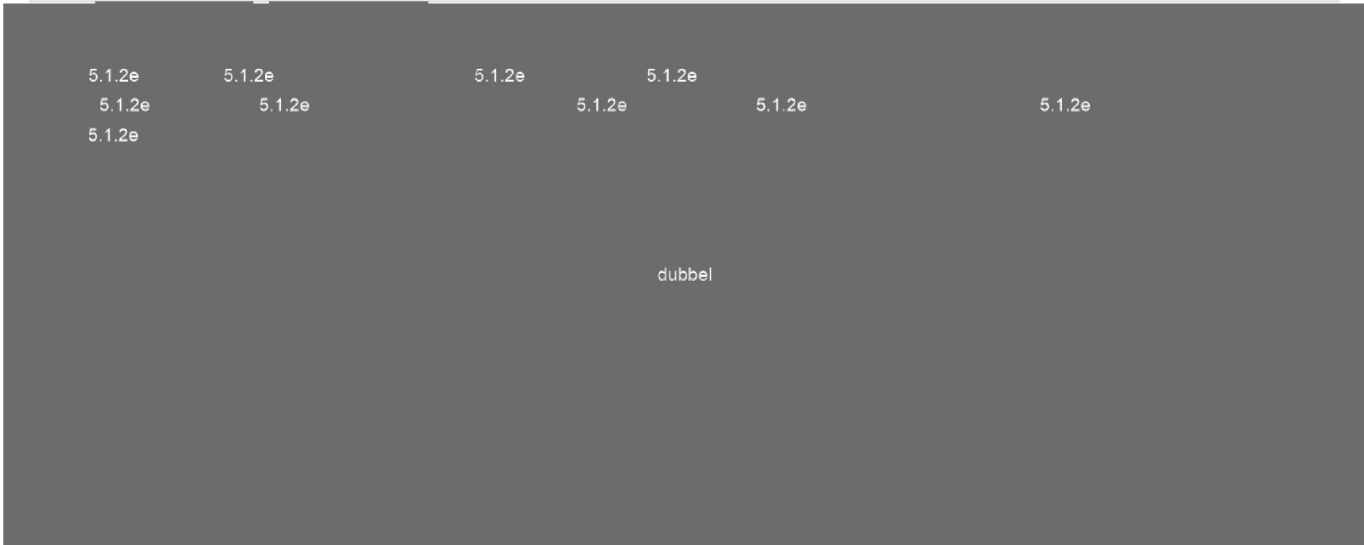
Privacy Impact Assessment/AVG regulations
