Urgentie: Hoog

Dear All,

Based on:

1. The expected increase in Covid-19 positive cases on Sint Maarten as a result of high infection rates on Curacao, Bonaire and Aruba,
2. The updated data and graphs in the PPT presentation shared with you this morning,
3. The discussion and your inputs during the special VMT meeting this afternoon,
4. The fact that a discussion has taken place between VWS SG Blokhuis of the Netherlands and Minister Panneflek of VSA during the Easter weekend (without my knowledge and presence) where it has apparently been decided to introduce an increased interval period between 1st and 2nd vaccination on Sint Maarten,

in the interest of providing maximum protection against Covid-19 to the population of Sint Maarten,

I have decided the following:

1. Increase the interval period between 1st and 2nd vaccination from 3 to 5 weeks for the general 18-59 public without underlying conditions, effective as of Monday April 12th, until further notice.
2. Prepare for implementation of this decision by Friday April 9th.
3. Maintain the current 3 weeks interval period between 1st and 2nd vaccination for the vulnerable population (60+ and persons with underlying conditions).
4. Prepare a press release announcing and clearly explaining the upcoming vaccination policy change, to be published on Thursday April 8th.
5. Prepare VAL management staff and [redacted] for implementation of the vaccination policy change.
6. Create a pool of essential VAL staff for CPS and Belair.
7. Prepare for increased vaccination capacity at Belair from 6 to 8 lines (768 persons per day).

Thank you all for your kind understanding and cooperation in the matter.

Onderwerp: Presentation in preparation of Special VMT meeting this afternoon at 14:00

Dear All,

Attached please find a presentation with the latest update and prognosis regarding our Vaccination Campaign on Sint Maarten.

You will see that we will hit the ceiling of registrations within two weeks if we accelerate vaccinating persons for their first vaccination if we prolong the interval between 1st and 2nd vaccination, assuming that registrations do not substantially increase this week and the next.

If we postpone all persons for their second vaccination as of today we would be able to vaccinate a total of 2.756 additional persons for their first vaccination before hitting the registration ceiling on April 19th.

The big question to be answered this afternoon is whether this advantage outweighs the possible negative side effects such as;

1. Public confusion about the delay
2. Public concern that *uitstel* is going to be *afstel*, fear that delay for the second vaccination will lead to no second vaccination at all
3. Negative public sentiments about the vaccination campaign, affecting our credibility, reducing vaccination acceptance rates and registration

Looking forward to meet you at 14:00.
