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1 Introduction

This document is assessing the risks associated with the project Corowell and the mitigation plan of these risks. The core of the project is software developed for a COVID-19 Symptom Screening Test device residing on a paper card and Mobile Phone platform such as an iPhone. The Mobile Phone is a standard device designed and manufactured by e.g. Apple and out of scope of this document. Only the software and the usage of it are evaluated in this document.

The audience for this document is QA personnel, auditors and senior management.

2 Evaluation Criteria and ranking System

2.1 Likelihood of Failure Occurrence

Definition:			
<p><i>O is the probability of occurrence of HARM. This number considers of two aspects, P1: the probability of a HAZARDOUS SITUATION occurring and P2: probability of a HAZARDOUS SITUATION leading to a HARM. These two aspects influence the probability that a harm occurs.</i></p> <p><i>For estimating Software errors the probability of a "HAZARDOUS SITUATION occurs" must be assume with 100%. But that does not mean that the probability of "OCCURANCE OF HARM" is always estimated with 5. The second aspect can reduce the probability.</i></p>

Definition:			
S is the severity level for a specific harm under the assumption that the harm will occur. The likelihood for the sequence of events leading to this harm is irrelevant and shall not be considered for the qualification of the severity level.

2.4 Criteria for Risk Acceptability

The risk acceptance criteria the following assessment criteria are given:

- S: Severity;
- O: Occurrence of harm; Probability that a harm accrues.

Based on this evaluation criteria the following key figures are calculated:

- **RISK:** Estimated Risk is a product of O x S

Description	Symbol	Description
Broadly acceptable	$1 < \text{RISK} \leq 10$	Risk is broadly acceptable \Rightarrow no need to consider further risk reduction
Intolerable, not acceptable	$\text{RISK} > 10$	Risk is intolerable/unacceptable and must be reduced by reducing the severity and/or the likelihood/probability of the hazard (otherwise, stopping the project should be considered)

4 Intended Controls and Measures

Preventive actions and detection methods for the various potential hazards, hazardous situations have been listed within the scope of the performed Preliminary Hazard Analysis (PHA).

Part of the preventive and detective actions based on controls to be performed during development, manufacturing and/or assembly of 'Corowell COVID-19 Symptom Screening Test' or after assembly completion (final test and checks).

Intended Controls or Recommended actions are only given on first appearance.

This section describes the planned and taken measures used in risk analysis. These measures are grouped in 3 categories:

- Design (D)
- Verification Test or Protective Measure (V)
- Labeling (L) [e.g. warning message, notices in manual

5 Summary

5.1 Residual Risk Evaluation

The PHA was performed during the design of *Corowell COVID-19 Symptom Screening Test*. The Risk Consideration has identified different potential hazards or hazardous situations that are related to safety or can cause harm. These potential harms are listed in *CW-20-0012 Risk Consideration* document. None were rated as critical after implementation of intended controls and suitable measures.

All intended measures are implemented, reviewed and lead to no other potential risks.

5.2 RISK /BENEFIT ASSESSMENT

Based on the evaluated low residual risk, the risk-benefit-ratio for the patient is considered to be acceptable.
