Feiten & cijfers	<p><b><u>Gebruik mondkapjes:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Verplicht in OV, winkels, medische praktijken en waar 1,5m afstand niet kan (zoals contactberoepen en "im öffentlichen Personennahverkehr").</li> <li>• Mond-/neusbedekking mag sjaal, bandana of zelfgemaakt zijn.</li> <li>• Medische maskers voorbehouden aan zorgverleners (cfm. WHO) ook gezien tekort.</li> <li>• Geen wetenschappelijke overtuiging dat masker per se helpt tegen besmetting (cfm. WHO).</li> <li>• Masker kan helpen als deel van breder palet aan preventiemaatregelen (cfm. Additional information	For cases of a regional increase in infections (cumulative number of more than 50 new infections per 100,000 inhabitants in a county within the previous 7 days) the Länder provide for a strict restriction concept Digital "contact tracing": decentralized and "open source" approach. Principle of "double voluntariness" applies, i.e. European and German data protection rules are strictly observed and only epidemiologically relevant contacts from the past three weeks are saved anonymously and only on the user's mobile phone without recording the movement profile. In addition, the app shall be used on a voluntary basis and data shall be passed on to the Robert Koch Institute (Federal Health Institute) only on a voluntary basis and in order to optimize the app and for epidemiological research.
