It is organized by our contractor, the EUHealthSupport consortium led by the National Institute for Public Health and the Environment, The Netherlands.

Background information:

- The Post-COVID-19 surveillance study aims to support the development of integrated surveillance system at EU level, assist and support Member States in the improvement of national surveillance systems, driven by digital transformation. This study was funded by the EU4Health Programme Annual work plan 2021.
- The contractor has performed a review of integrated surveillance systems, which is expected to identify key issues that
 require further in-depth knowledge exchange. The final findings from the scoping review will be presented to the national
 expert groups during structured webinars (ECOVID-Net working group of competent bodies for surveillance of
 communicable diseases, Joint Action Integrated Surveillance consortia and Health security committee members).
- In parallel, an online survey was launched to gather the knowledge and experience of national surveillance experts and policy makers. The initial findings of this survey will be presented during the webinar.
- In addition, three (parallel) breakout sessions will be organised in order to facilitate an exchange of practices and lessons learnt among key stakeholders and experts at EU level on the following main topics:
 - 1. Legal barriers and legal solutions for data sharing;
 - 2. Digitalisation, including the use of new data sources;
 - 3. Data integration, such as technical aspects to data linking and standardisation of case definition
