on behalf of the European Commission, we cordially invite you to an **online Real time Delphi** survey on different futures in **research and innovation** in PostCovid-19 times. The Delphi statements are derived from five alternative scenarios that all have the possibility to unfold during the next years until 2030. This survey is part of a Foresight on Demand project - building and analysing Post Covid-19 scenarios for the European Commission. Five scenarios were created after a literature analysis and a Scenario Sprint.
