Thank you for your email – This is indeed a sad case, as it is on all occasions when we learn of child born with a disease.

As I have informed [redacted] 5.1.2e from the IGJ earlier today, no distributions have been made to Dutch clinics. Originally, we included one Dutch clinic on our clinic list that was issued via the rapid alert, but upon additional investigations of paper records (bear in mind that this donor was active in 2005), we can now conclude, that the clinic previously listed in fact did **not** receive sperm straws from the affected donor.

When creating the clinic list, we generally choose to include any clinic that our system may associate with a given donor. This might in rare cases result in the inclusion of information that, upon closer inspection, does not reflect actual donor movement or treatment.

Regarding your question about clinic notification: when we issue a rapid alert to authorities, we also send notifications to each clinic on the associated clinic list. These emails are sent with tracking enabled, allowing us to confirm successful delivery to an active inbox. Our team review the delivery logs, and if any notification appears undelivered, we take further steps to reach the clinic e.g., with the help of our national authorities. To date, we have no indication that any clinic failed to receive the information.

For transparency, we note that two Dutch residents have been treated with the donor at two separate clinics in Belgium. Both Belgian clinics were notified and were included on the clinic list submitted to authorities in 2023 as part of the rapid alert.
