Ontwikkelen van interventies obv behaviour insights is belegd bij de BIT-teams van de ministeries – voor de pandemie samenwerkend in een rapid response team. Daarover wordt echter nog niet veel gecommuniceerd.

Dear 5.1.2e

On behalf of the entire EuroHealthNet team, let me express my best wishes to you for a healthy and happy 2021!

This year, EuroHealthNet looks forward to supporting collective efforts to foster a successful and fair exit from the pandemic and to build societies resilient to health, social and climate crises.

As a part of these efforts, and on behalf of EuroHealthNet's President and Executive Board, **we would like to invite you to an extraordinary Policy and Strategy Meeting on Wednesday, 24 February 2021, 10:00 – 12:30. Please save the date!** We will send more detailed logistical information soon. We would like each of our members, associates and observers to send at least one senior delegate to this meeting, as if it were a General Council Meeting.

The policy environment is changing quickly. With this meeting we aim to inform you about the changes happening at the international level, and seek your input on how we should shape our collaborative work.

This meeting is meant to provide you with unique insights over recent EU and WHO policy developments and funding opportunities and to **lay the groundwork for our 2021 policy and advocacy activities**, and beyond as per our strategic direction for the post-2021 period.

It can also be considered as a mid-term opportunity to get together before we meet again at our **online General Council Meeting on Wednesday 9 June, 2021 (please save this date too!)**.

On our meeting in 24 February, we will specifically discuss:

1. The recent developments around the **European Health Union**, a new European initiative to protect citizens' health, support Member States in preventing future pandemics, and make health systems more resilient. We will cover the Health Union principles and directions, and how to position national public health institutes in these developments. *To what extent do we want EuroHealthNet engaged in the high-level discussions around the future of health policy at the EU level? What can and should we do together?*
2. The state of play of the two **main funding programmes of the European Union** – the Multiannual Financial Framework (MFF) 2021-2027 (The EU's long term budget) and NextGenerationEU (a new funding facility launched in response to the COVID-19 pandemic). We will zoom in on the new EU Recovery and Resilience Facility and on the EU4Health programme of which a minimum of 20% will need to be spent on health promotion and disease prevention. *How best can we jointly influence the prioritisation of investments in health equity and the implementation of the EU funding at (sub) national levels?*
3. A Memorandum of Understanding between WHO and EuroHealthNet, contributing to the **WHO European Programme of Work**. *What will be EuroHealthNet's added value and how can we collaborate on flagship initiatives such as digital health, immunization, mental health and behavioural insights? Should we set up more Thematic Working Groups (TWIGs)? Who would want to be involved?*

The meeting will be designed in such a way to allow Directors and highest management level to participate only in the first part of the meeting. In the second part, we will use break out groups to discuss how we can take forward **key EU policies and initiatives**, also in the context of our **2020 external evaluation**, of our **Foresight exercise** and informing our strategic development plan post-2021 to be approved at the General Council Meeting in June.

The Executive Board will prepare the agenda for our extraordinary Policy and Strategy Meeting on 28 February after which we will send you further information and a registration link. We would be delighted to be able to meet you all again, albeit online!

A Recovery Plan for the European Union – 2021: a crucial year

We would like to take this opportunity to already update you on a pressing development. Over the past months, national governments and EU institutions discussed and approved the largest financial instrument ever put in place by the European Union: The Recovery and Resilience Facility (RRF). The RRF consists of **€312.5 billion in grants and up to €360 billion in loans** and will support EU countries in setting out major reform programmes over the next 4 years to face short- and long-term challenges related to COVID-19, as well as bringing innovation to sectors that will benefit the most (e.g. health). The RRF will also stand at the core of the European Semester 2021 cycle, which has been fully refocused to ensure the implementation of this new funding instrument. Early 2021 is a crucial moment for countries to finalise the first drafts of the National Plans for Recovery and Resilience, also known as Recovery Plans, which are due by the end of

April 2021.

National governments have been instructed by the EU to conduct stakeholders' consultations for the design of their national Recovery Plans to ensure that all challenges are adequately addressed. EuroHealthNet would like to seize this opportunity and ensure that **health equity, public health, health promotion and disease prevention are fully embedded in the national Recovery Plans**.

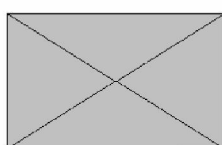
